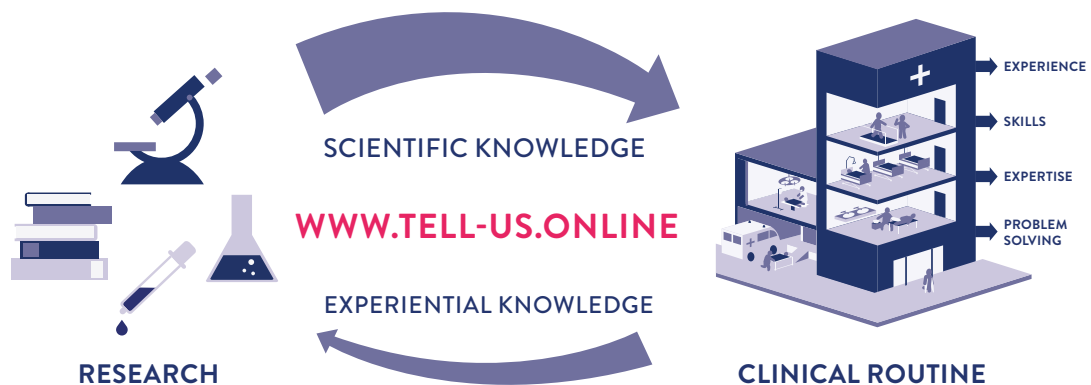




TELL US!

Who knows best how to examine and treat traumatic traffic or sports injuries? The answer is: people who deal with these on a daily basis – i.e. physicians, therapists, nurses or orderlies. But the patients themselves have also gained first-hand experience that can be **useful to research**.

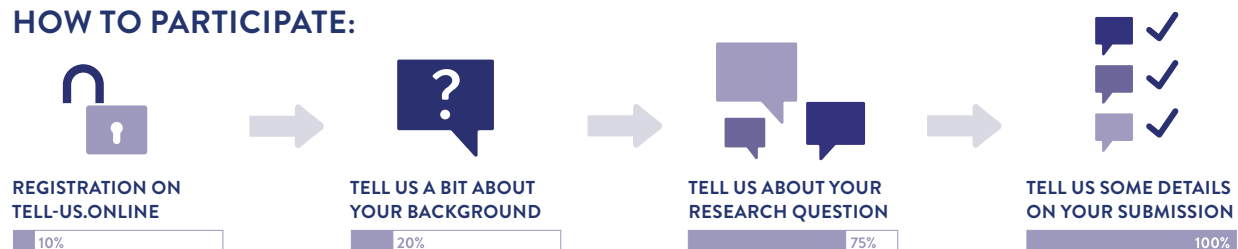


Research in the field of injury diagnosis and treatment is usually carried out by researchers from specialized disciplines. Despite improvements in medical care in the field of accidental injuries, **conventional research does not always meet the clinical needs of patients**. To improve diagnosis and treatment after accidents, it is absolutely necessary to **incorporate clinical experience into research**.

"Tell us!" is a crowdsourcing project from the Ludwig Boltzmann Gesellschaft, carried out in cooperation with the Ludwig Boltzmann Institute for Clinical and Experimental Traumatology. Over a period of **8 weeks**, we are **deploying an online platform in the search for new research questions** that can subsequently be included in research.
